

Blue Waters Bluegrass Festival Volunteer Summary

Volunteers are an essential part of the Blue Waters Bluegrass Festival. We are so fortunate to have a large group of generous, enthusiastic, friendly, and hard working volunteers. The volunteers are the first to greet visitors when they arrive, and really set the tone for a fun filled weekend. Volunteers who work 8 hours get a weekend pass; 4 hours equals a 1 day pass.

The following is a summary of the available volunteer positions. Please look through them and on the application, select as many as interest you. You will be assigned these positions on a first come, first serve basis. Also, please indicate your preferred times/days, and I will do my best to accommodate you.

Set Up/ Tear Down: We need a large crew to set up the festival on Thursday and to tear down on Sunday afternoon. This position involves some heavy lifting, and possible ladder usage. This is a position that won't interfere with the festival schedule as it is done before or after the festival. So you are free to enjoy the whole event. Most people do both set up and tear down for a full weekend pass, but if you can do only one shift (either set up OR tear down), please specify.

Merchandise Tent: We are looking for volunteers who have experience or a desire to do sales. This is where we sell T shirts, caps, CDs, etc. , so promotion of the merchandise is our goal. A volunteer in this position should also feel comfortable handling money, credit cards, cash register, etc.

Ticket Gate: Volunteers in this position should be comfortable handling money or credit cards. This is where tickets are sold, and wristbands are given out. The ability to focus and multitask during high volume times is essential here.

Golf Cart Drivers: We need a large group of people who can drive golf carts to enable visitors to go from their cars to the festival grounds. This is often quite a distance as the festival has grown over the years. Being outgoing, but focused are two important attributes that are a plus in this position. Being a careful driver is also essential of course.

Gate Checkers: Medical Lake Scope members have always been invaluable at the exit /entrance gates where we check people to make sure they have the correct wristband for the day. This is a good position for people who are more comfortable sitting. Focus is essential to watch each person entering the festival.

Parking Greeter: If you are friendly and enjoy greeting people, this is the job for you. Parking Greeters meet people entering the parking lot, determining if they are there for the festival or just to enjoy the lake. They then direct them to open parking spaces.

Assistant Campground host: We have two camping areas: tent camping and R.V. parking. Those assisting the camp hosts will help visitors find camping spots, direct them to the front gate to pay for camping, and ensure that everyone has a paid sticker/tag. Some visitors may need direction in parking their R.V., or in a reminder of the camp rules. If you choose this position, please specify if you would prefer the tent camp or the R.V. camp.
